

## Exotic/Reptile Pre-Examination Questionnaire

In order for us to best prepare for your pet's visit, please complete the following:

1. Please answer the questions below, being as complete as possible. Please email the questionnaire to [barringtonvet@yahoo.com](mailto:barringtonvet@yahoo.com) at least 24 hours prior to appointment.
2. Along with the questionnaire, please email a photo of your pet's cage and surroundings.
3. Please bring a fecal sample, the fresher the better.
4. Please bring all previous records. Records can be emailed prior to appointment as well.

### General Husbandry and Care Questions

- Origin - where did you get this animal, and how long ago
- Age, sex, reproductive history
- Enclosure - indoor/outdoor; orientation (horizontal or vertical); size; construction materials; cage furniture (substrate, hides; climbing branches, water and feed dishes); ventilation; frequency and method of cleaning
- Heating - what temperature; temperature gradient; how is it provided; how is it monitored; how is it controlled; winter cooling
- Humidity - what humidity is in the cage; how is it provided; how is it monitored; how is it controlled
- UVB - how is it provided; access to unfiltered sunlight; how old are any artificial UVB sources
- Feeding - what with; how often; date of last meal
- Are any supplements being given; how often and when was the last time it was given
- When did the reptile last shed - any difficulties with any shedding; any assistance required
- When did the reptile last defecate

- Routine husbandry treatments - mites and internal parasite treatments - what with and how frequently; last treatment given when
- New arrivals - where from; quarantine procedures and treatments
